When [Jobs4teens](#) first launched in early 2018 we were an Online Jobs Board looking for small local businesses to post a vacancy for a low-cost listing fee.

The business model was sound but the ambition to have the website designed and built to run smoothly for both Registered Teenagers and Small Business owners was difficult to achieve.

We want to be in a position to re-introduce an Online Jobs Board to our website in late 2019.

The very simple concept was for any business to list a vacancy on the Online Jobs Board, and Teenagers simply respond to the listing as required.

However, the concept could have been misused by some Business Owners who could have listed inappropriate jobs, or listings could have been posted by Business Owners who were not willing or able to comply with the Legislation governing Teenage Employment.

We consider the safety and wellbeing of the Teenagers to be the absolute most important factor in our thinking and this is what led to us insisting that any Business Owner wanting to employ our services become a Member.

All Members will agree to abide by the prevailing Child Employment Legislation and any other good practices associated with employing a Teenager.

The goal we want to achieve later this year is where Teenagers can Register with us and by doing so they will have access to our Online Jobs Board and know that any Job Vacancy posted on there has been listed by Business Owner who has been vetted by us.
